2012 Big Butte Challenge



The Big Butte Challenge's unique starting procedure had the 5K and the 11K runners start at once while facing one another. After the starting horn, the two groups passed by each other on opposite sides of the street. The two starting lines were slightly further apart this year due to the starting lines being adjusted backwards to compensate for the usual finish line moving outside the Mining Museum's locked gate.

Saturday, 7 April – The Butte Family YMCA started its 32nd Annual Big Butte Challenge a little after 9 a.m. Saturday, after the previous day had layered the race courses with slick ice and areas of 10⁺ cm of snow cover. The snow-over-ice combination made the 11K route straight up and over Big Butte especially challenging. There were several runners who slipped and fell during the races. The clear and calm morning sky allowed the sunshine to warm the temperature from -2 °C at the start to just above freezing when the 11K runners were finishing. Race officials reported that about ninety total runners and walkers competed in the three races, but results were not made available for 5K walkers or for the 1-mile fun run. Amanda Badovinac of Butte was the winner of the women's 5K in 30:45, and Butte High's 19 year old Josh Panasuk was the men's 5K winner. Panasuk's 18:02 finish was the fifth fastest time ever in the 5K race. The standing course record of 16:42 was set by Pat Judge under milder, late May conditions in 1994.
