

## Bussing, Photo ID Required for On-Bus Number Distribution, & SWAG

On race morning, after you park your car as directed on the NORTH side of I-90, you will have only one thing to do... **take your photo ID (or equivalent) and your personal weatherproof gear bag with you onto the correct bus for the ride to the starting area.** Your gear bag should be reasonably compact and clearly marked with your name.

You are NOT allowed to let another runner race using your bib number, and such an act would likely result in your recipient's embarrassment and disqualification. There IS an acceptable method of transferring your registration prior to 11:59 p.m., Monday, 17 June via cancellation credit. Please [email](#) if you won't make it to the race and need help cancelling.

Bussing assignments and exact bussing schedules will be posted on the race website on Wed, 19 June, and hardcopies of the same lists will be posted on the bulletin board in the NORTH Homestake Trailhead lot on race morning. Who rides which bus will be determined by the seeding of runners for the start, and seeding will not be done until registration closes at 12:01 a.m. on 19 June. Exact details about seeding and starting procedures will also come in a subsequent posting.

The **first of five busses will arrive at 0730 hrs for immediate boarding.** It will then depart at 0745 hrs. The four remaining busses will depart periodically thereafter. The bus ride to the unloading zone will last ~20 minutes, leaving you at least 30 minutes to travel by foot from your bus to the starting line. You will be able to identify your bus by its numbered sign (1 through 5). Please do not attempt to ride an earlier bus because switching busses would cause you to miss getting your assigned race number. You would also occupy a spot that is reserved for someone who is scheduled to start the race before you.

**Race number distribution: Once you are on your assigned bus, present your photo ID to the race representative who is issuing race bib numbers.** Make sure your race number has your name on it. Your number will come with 4 safety-pins to **fasten the number visibly on the front of your outermost garment throughout the race.** Please do not pin your number's **tear-off tag** to your clothes. The tag's hole is needed by the finish line crew. During your bus ride, you will also be given last minute verbal instructions to help you remember the other important stuff. Race numbers unclaimed during the bus ride will be left at the unloading zone.

If the weather is inclement, your bus driver has instructions to stay at the unloading zone until the last rider chooses to brave the outdoors. Your bus will NOT return to Homestake after unloading. There will be a gear truck taking your gear bags, below east, where the CDT crosses the highway. That is also where the two final 'honey buckets' will be.

**T-shirts, 50/50 tickets, & Wulfssock distribution:** If you purchased a race **t-shirt and or 50/50 raffle ticket(s), they will be issued to you shortly after you finish the race.** Your stuff will be marked with your race number. No shirt exchanges will be allowed unless there are leftovers available at the post race picnic. You lucky first-50 registrants will also get your free Wulfssocks at the t-shirt station. Complimentary refreshments will also be available there.

**Keep your number** (and pins) with you after the race because the number doubles as your **ticket into the post race picnic** at Homestake Lodge. We will recycle those items for you.
