

## Post-Race Picnic & 50/50 Raffle

Wulfman's CDT-14K will be followed immediately by a **picnic, prize drawing, and awards ceremony** that you will not want to miss. It all happens at Homestake Lodge, beginning as runners arrive **from ~11 a.m. until ~1:30 p.m.**

**Car-pooling is strongly encouraged** for the 5K drive to *Homestake Lodge*. Chris & Mandy, who own and operate the Lodge, kindly support Wulfman's race by hosting this picnic. Most of their parking for a crowd our size is at road-side, so the fewer cars there the better.

**Directions:** Drive gravel surfaced Forest Service Road 240 (Rader Creek) SE from the Homestake Pass (this year's finish line) until you go under the big electrical transmission lines, where you will see a road to your right that leads to the Lodge. Golden VIP's will enjoy premium parking in front of the Lodge.

The Lodge's new wooden pavilion will provide shade for seating and eating. **Bring your race number (and pins) because it is your free ticket in.** We will recycle them for you. **We do NOT sell extra picnic passes on race-day**, but you can still purchase more \$7 picnic passes now online by logging into your account (or using your confirmation number) at [IMAthlete](#). If you have purchased extra picnic passes for your "posse," those will be listed at the entrance to the food line at the Lodge's front door.

Masseurs from the Asten Center will be on site at the picnic to provide their services for gratuity.

Again this year, Wulfman's Race Committee made the commitment to provide you with the highest quality of picnic foods available in our market. Although we feel uncertain that Wulfman would have endorsed our plan, we have gone **organic and beyond** where possible, and Butte's *Hennessy Market* has helped us make that move.

We are offering **two types of mouthwatering homemade chili**, each made by Michele Bazzanella, Eddi Walker and company. There will be delectable **chili con carne** plus **harvest chili** made with ingredients that we think everyone, vegans and meat-eaters alike, will love!

You may garnish your choice of chili with **grated cheddar**, and the chili's final compliment will be 100% whole wheat **bread** made by *Great Harvest Bakery*. You may also enjoy a side of corn **chips & fresh salsa**. The salsa will be hand made from organics by Amber Wood-Jensen and Angie Welles the evening before the race.

Picnic items will also include **sweet potato salad**, and a variety of **fresh fruit** and **cookies**.

If none of those foods appetize you, then you may try PB&J sandwiches made with real **Adams' peanut butter**, or feel free to bring picnic items of your own.

We'll have beverages too. In addition to water (and coffee if it's cold outside), Butte's *Quarry Brewery* will provide **complimentary beer**. The Wulfman preferred *Miller Lite* from the can, but we think you'll be happier with the local brew. Have a designated driver among your car-pool if you are taking advantage of the free beer.

A 50/50 raffle will be drawn at the post race picnic and you must be present to win, in fact, you must be there to win any and all prizes and awards during the coinciding awards ceremony. More details about awards will come later. The raffle winner will take 50% of the total raffle sales and the other half will be added to other race proceeds in benefiting trails in the *Beaverhead-Deerlodge NF*. Fifty/Fifty tickets are also still available through [IMAthlete](#). You will also be able to purchase 50/50 tickets at the picnic for our regular price of \$2 ea.
