

Welcome, Cancellation Credits, Fine-Tuning Registration, Extra Picnic Passes, Raffle

We, *Butte's Piss & Moan Runners*, **thank you** for registering to run Wulfman's 14 km, Continental Divide Trail race on Saturday, 22 June. Each year we post daily informational releases during the final weeks prior to the race. That time is nearly upon us and we're excited about it! The daily posts will be placed at the bottom of the [Wulfpage](#). Check there daily, starting 6 June. We will attempt to tell you everything you want to know about the event, including such critical details as bussing assignments, starting procedures and seeded starting times. The **vital details within each posting will be highlighted in bold green** to make quick scanning easier for ultra-busy folks.

Wulfman's traditional 240-person registration cap filled on 16 February this year, and that disappointed many late-coming runners who later tried to register at the regular price. A small handful of those preregistered have already canceled out of this year's race, and their empty registration slots were immediately snapped up. At this moment, the only way to enter Wulfman's race is to buy one of the remaining \$100 "Golden VIP" Charity registration slots.

Early registration always puts you at risk for paying money and then later becoming unable to attend. We know some of you are experiencing that sad realization right now, and we want to help you out by offering you a **75% credit for cancelling your registration before noon, Friday, 7 June**. The simple cancellation steps are listed at the bottom of this message. The return credit amount thereafter drops to 50% until the final cancellation deadline passes at 11:59 p.m., Monday, 17 June -- 24 hours before registration ultimately closes. Wulfman's registration slots are rare, so please make sure your spot on the starting line is occupied, and please also beware that it is NOT okay for you to give your bib number to another runner, and such an act would likely result in your recipient's embarrassment and disqualification. It is easy to cancel your registration. Don't delay, and if you can't make it work then you may [email](#) for help.

After you cancel, you have the option to wait until next year to put your credit toward registering yourself again for Wulfman's race, or you could immediately sell or give away your credit code to another runner who may then use it to register this year (assuming an opening) or next.

When you registered, you may have under/overestimated your predicted finish time due to a variety of reasons including your unexpected changes in ability or your inexperience running hilly trails at high altitude. The accuracy of your predicted time is important because we use it to help us figure out a fair starting order and because we award a prize for the most accurate prediction. Step#4 below may also be slightly modified to **fine-tune registration details such as your estimated finish time**. Just click the "Go" button next to "Change current registration details"

Step #1 below will also give you access to **buy extra picnic passes for your "posse" or 50/50 raffle tickets**. Just click the links for those items on the right side of your screen. Your race bib number is your picnic ticket, and you must buy any needed extra passes online because **NO walk-up picnic tickets will be sold on race-day again this year**. The 50/50 raffle will be drawn at the post race picnic and you must be present to win. The raffle winner will take 50% of the total raffle sales and the other half will be added to other race proceeds in benefiting trails in the Beaverhead-Deerlodge NF District.

Here is how to cancel your registration for return credit:

- 1) Log in to your user account at [IMAthlete.com](#).
- 2) Click the "My Registrations" drop-down list on the IMAthlete page menu bar and then select "Edit Registrations."
- 3) Locate and click your "Manage Registration" link just below the hyperlink for Wulfman's race.
- 4) Click the "Go" button next to the "Cancel registration for partial credit" option.
- 5) Read the terms of cancellations, and after affirming your agreement with those terms, click the "Submit" button.
