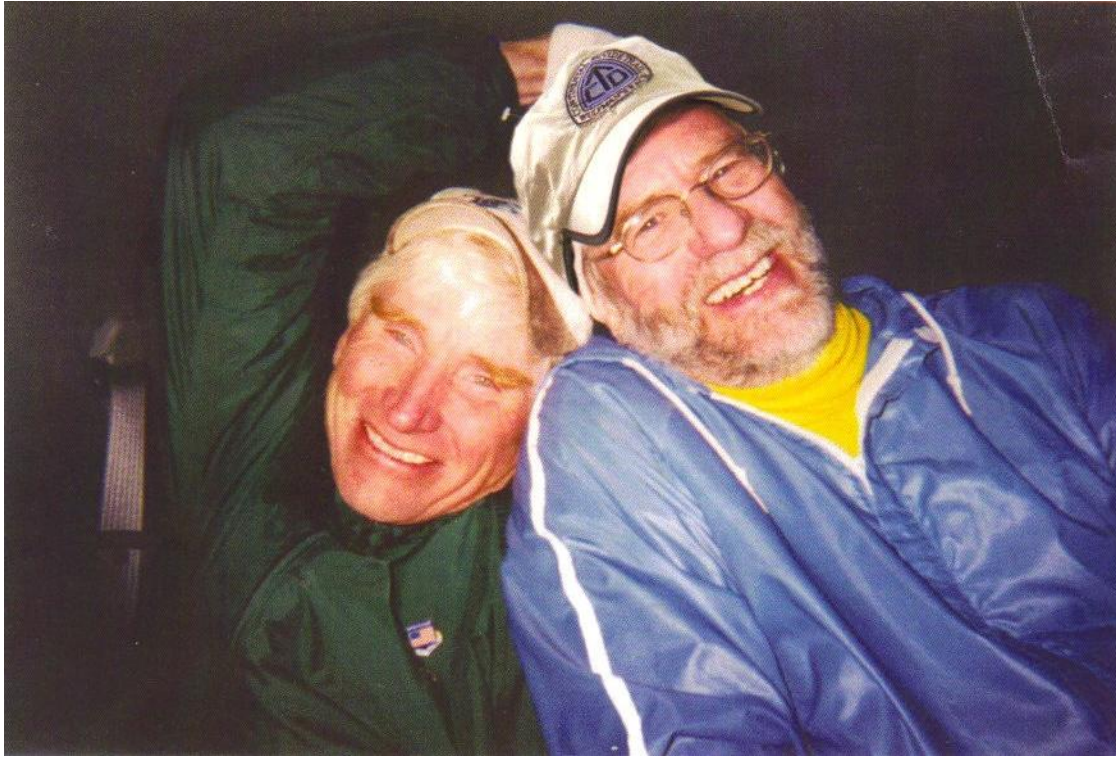


The Wulfman and the Golden Charity VIPs
