

8 June Post – Directions, Parking, & Honey Bucket Port-a-Pottie

Think car-pool! To find Wulfman’s race site, exit Interstate Highway 90 at its highest elevation point between Butte and Whitehall at Homestake Pass, **Exit #233**, and then follow the signs and the directions of our volunteer parking attendants to designated **parking NORTH of I-90**. There, you will find posted lists telling who is assigned to which bus. More exact bussing and race number handout details will be revealed in subsequent postings, but please remember that **you must bring your photo ID (or equivalent) on your assigned bus to get your race number**.

Overflow parking is abundant, so **do not park on or near either I-90 off-ramp at any time!** Those areas are hazardous, so general safety and our club’s good standing with the Highway Department hang in the balance. **Nor should you park on the south side of I-90** -- that area is needed for ambulances and official vehicles and for finish line activities.

Also **please do not place a private car at the start area at Pipestone Pass**. Off-highway parking there is extremely cramped and desperately needed for operation of busses, gear trucks, emergency vehicles, official race vehicles and outhouses. The hwy at Pipestone Pass has an extremely dangerous, blind corner with just enough space to allow the busses’ tight fit. If your posse experiences an unstoppable notion to see you vanish into the forest at the start, they must park at the pullout that is located 1K below and east of the Pipestone Pass crest. Walking distance to the start from that lower pullout is equal (~500 m) to that from the pass.

Outhouses: As previously reported, Wulfman owned his own miniature “honey bucket” toilet, and he rarely traveled far without it, but we don’t expect you to match his high standard. Remember that our Golden VIPs may cut directly to the front of the honey bucket lines. There is one permanent USFS outhouse in Homestake’s northern parking lot. You will find **three honey buckets at the bus unloading zone** that is on the very top of Pipestone Pass, and there will be **two more honey buckets where the CDT crosses the hwy** ~300 m from the starting line. That is also where your gear-drop will be. After your race you will find one more honey bucket near the finish line, and Homestake Lodge will be equipped with three honey buckets for the post-race picnic.
