For the first time ever a separate race for high school girls was held during Veterans' Day in Butte. The first winner was Butte Central junior, Rose McCormick. She covered the one and a half mile course in 9:57.

The male winner for the second year in a row was Butte Central's Dave McDougall. He won in a record time of 12:30.



The final year of the seven-year Swede Dahlberg challenge went to Butte High. The Bulldogs beat Butte Central 27-29 in team competition. Butte High totaled a 21-point margin over Central with a seven-year count of 249 to 270. The Bulldogs will now retire the plaque at their school.
