65th Annual Butte American Legion MERDI/MSE Veterans' Day Race

Monday, 11 November 2002 - Hunt defends individual title as recapped by Pat Kearney for The Montana Standard

Competitors in the Veterans' Day race start the 5.2-mile course at Stodden Park, Monday morning.



Defending champion Ray Hunt of Deer Lodge breezed to victory in the Veterans' Day Race held at Stodden Park Monday. Hunt led from the start and easily won with a time

of 28:17 over the 5.2-mile course. Marv Speece of Melrose finished second with a clocking of 30:07. Mitch Cunningham of Whitehall was third. Hunt received the C. Owen Smithers trophy, named after one of the co-founders of the race.

Casey Campbell, a junior at Montana Tech, won the female race with a time of 34:01. Campbell, a member of Tech's women's basketball team, trailed nine-time champion Suzie Kaluza of Butte and 2000 winner Jennifer Thomas of Helena through the first mile. Campbell, from Lincoln, passed both former champions just before the two-mile mark and never looked back. Thomas was second with a time of 35:38 while Kaluza finished third in 36:13. Campbell won the Mary Whelan Trophy that was named after the first women's winner in the open division in 1976.

The winner of the boys' 14-and under 2.5-mile race was Hobie Biegler of Butte. His winning time was 18:17. Brandon Kearney was second and Casey Nichols third. Biegler received the Martin Kearney Trophy named after the 1940 champion and long-time race coordinator.

The top girls' performer in the 14-and-under 2.5-mile race was Keli Dennehy of Butte. She beat defending champion Melissa Bogert who was second. Sara Bogert was third. Dennehy won the Liza Merrifield Trophy named after the first junior high winner of this race in 1973. Keli is the daughter of Liza Merrifield Dennehy. Keli's mom and grandparents Charlie and Betty Merrifield presented Keli with her award.


