69th annual Butte American Legion Veterans' Day Race

Saturday, 11 November 2006 – A jog down memory lane by Dave Johnson of the Montana Standard

In 1946 Clar Renouard was 17. As a junior at Butte Central High School, Renouard raced in freezing temperatures to capture the ninth annual Butte Veterans' Day Race which was held in uptown Butte on November 11, 1946. Sixty years ago the race fell on a weekday, so Renouard left school with a buddy and ran the 2.5-mile Library Course that wound its way around Uptown on Wyoming and Idaho streets. It was the first race after World War II, and there were only five male runners in the race. Renouard crossed

the finish line in a time of 15 minutes and six seconds. Renouard was revisiting Butte on Saturday for the 69th Annual Butte Veterans' Day Race and was seen taking pictures of the 81 competitors at the start in Stodden Park. Renouard's son reported that Clar was quite happy about being back in Butte on the day of the veterans' race. "I played football and basketball like everyone else in high school," smiled Renouard. But he said he didn't train at all for the 1946 race and consequently paid the price. "I had shin splints for the next two weeks (after the race)," said Renouard. After high school in 1951 through 1953, Renouard served in the military in the Korean War. On Saturday, Clar (now 77 years old) was honored by 28-time participant and race director, Pat Kearney, who called to the awards table not only Renouard but also other past race winners. The group included Bill Kearney (1976, 1980), Ed Foley (1977), Nicole Hunt (1996, 2001, 2003, 2004, 2005), Ray Hunt (2001, 2002), and Liza Dennehy (1973, 1974, 1980). Clar Renouard ran the race in an era when most of the runners were high-school age athletes. After looking at past winners, this trend continued until about 1975 when the "running craze" took hold as a result of Frank Shorter's gold medal in the marathon at the 1972 Olympics.

On Saturday, the mix between high school and more mature runners continued. In the men's 5.2-mile race Peter Dan Sullivan from Helena won the overall award and the C. Owen Smithers trophy in a time of 31:20 while Michele Bazzanella took home the Mary Whelan trophy for winning the women's division. Bazzanella's time was 34:34. "It was windy and there was a headwind," said Bazzanella who lives in Helena. The course left Stodden Park and then turned north directly into the wind that continually dogged the runners until the final 300 yards when they turned east and into the finish by the American Legion building near the airport. Other winners on Saturday included longtime Butte runner Don Sundberg who won the 50-to-59 male division, and Sherry Vogel who captured the women's 50-to-59 division. Ed Foley, who won the race in 1977, topped his age group of runners in the 60-to-69 division. In the 2.5-mile race Butte High running ace, Keli

Dennehy, set a course record for the Stodden Course with her clocking of 16:52. Dennehy's time surpassed Wendy Lutgen's time of 17:14 set in 1987. Dennehy's win was her fifth in the under-14 division.
